Founded in 1965 as the American Association of Cost Engineers to advance the science and art of cost engineering, AACE International is an international non-profit organization. AACE represents cost engineers, cost estimators, project managers, planners and schedulers, and other professionals engaged in all facets of Total Cost Management.

AACE provides a forum for the exchange of ideas about problems and advances in project controls in all types of industry. Through publications and meetings (local, national, and international) AACE keeps its members informed about important project controls issues.

Membership Requirements

Membership in AACE consists of three following classifications:

Member- An individual who has been engaged professionally in cost management or cost engineering and who has a minimum of six years professional cost management experience that may include up to four years of full-time studies in a relevant degree program.

Associate Member- An individual interested in AACE membership, who does not specifically qualify as a member.

Student Member- An individual who is enrolled in a curriculum relevant to Total Cost Management as a full-time student in a college or university

Certification

AACE offers professional certification by examination. Designation of Certified Cost Consultant (CCC) or Engineer (CCE) is used. An Interim Cost Consultant or Engineer (ICC/ICE) is also used for new graduates without the work experience. Planning & Scheduling Professional (PSP), Earned Value Professional (EVP), and Certified Forensic Consultant (CFC) are also available for individuals specializing in those areas.
